

ACCREDITED CLINICAL EDUCATORS COURSE 2019 (ACE)

- NAVP have worked with NOCN to accredit this ACE course with specific aims towards helping the animal/veterinary physiotherapist students. The course will address what is required from an educator in all the relevant areas of clinical teaching, placements and skills logs.
- It will be run on an annual basis to give everyone a chance to attend.
- This course will become a requirement for any NAVP member who is, or wants to become involved with teaching or providing placements for students on university animal/veterinary physiotherapy postgraduate or undergraduate courses.
- From 2020 all current PPs and tutors are expected to have completed this course.

(For members who already hold a teaching certificate attendance will not be necessary).

COURSE DETAILS.

The course will be held over three days and delivered by Sarah Harris PgD Vet Phys. PGCE.

Prior to studying veterinary physiotherapy and gaining her post graduate degree, Sarah ran her own training company for 12 years providing training to the NHS, local authorities and private companies.

Course Dates: 11th and 12th May, and 8th June 2019.

All 3 days must be attended to receive your ACE Certificate.

COURSE OUTLINE.

- General information relating to learning and development; communication, theories, roles and responsibilities.
- Methods and teaching for 1:1 and group facilitation.
- Placements: paperwork, planning, health and safety.
- Reviewing placement paperwork.
- Micro teaching session: 10-15 mins on a pre-selected subject.
