Further directions:

From the South/East-

M1 junction 17 take the A45

Continue to the end of the M45

At the roundabout take the 3rd exit (going back down the M45)

Take the first exit sp Daventry/A45

Take the 2nd exit

First turn Right sp Grandborough

First turn Right into Castle Lane (not sp)

First Right property – double electric gates, wooden railing fencing – Castle Farm. Use the first entrance you get to: double electric gates.

From the West-

Pick up the A45 from Coventry or Warwick and aim for Dunchurch/M45

Or use the M40 Junction 12, aim for Southam, Grandborough and Woolscott (which is not signposted). This is the long way round.

Accommodation

There are various B and B's available if you search the internet. Castle Farm is close to Rugby, Daventry, Leamington.

There is a Travelodge about 3 miles away, on the A45 and it would be the closest to the yard that is a reasonable price.
