Veterinary Physiotherapists do not treat prescriptively but always approach each case on an individual basis. To be able to do this they need to be able to assess and monitor tissue response, this adds crucial information and allows us to monitor the effects of our intervention.

There is no valid substitute for skillful palpation which allows us to ascertain relatively minute structural changes – primary and reflex – that often have far-reaching effects on the body.

This CPD will be mostly practical using demonstrations plus hands on time for delegates. It aims to enhance your palpation skills thus enabling you to match your findings to the case history and your static and dynamic observations.

Halina has worked as a Veterinary Physiotherapist for 35 years and has been a senior tutor on Veterinary Physiotherapy degree courses for 10 years. As well as having a busy equine practice she also holds a weekly sports therapy clinic for riders.

Over her many years in practice she has seen cases where tissue dysfunction has not been correctly identified, thus leaving the animal to continue to work in pain and owners believing it to be only a ‘behavioral’ problem. Halina firmly believes that our aims of ensuring the welfare of the animals in our care should begin with correct identification of tissue dysfunction and the degree to which it affects the individual case.
